**Scripture Reflection**

We continue with the theme of the revelation of the fullness of who Jesus is. It is John the Baptist who announces him as the Lamb of God – the ultimate Paschal Lamb. Andrew then introduces Peter to Jesus (Gospel:1:35-42). The Lord reveals himself to Samuel who listens to understand he is being called (First Reading: 1 Samuel 3:3-310,19). St. Paul teaches the Corinthians the sacredness of the human body (Second Reading: Corinthians 6:13-15,17-20).

**Responsorial Psalm meditation:** ‘Here I am, Lord, I come to do your will (Psalm 39/40:7).

You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.
