**Scripture Reflection**

The Gospel today is an extract from the Prologue of John's Gospel. It introduces the ministry of John the Baptist and declares that he is a witness for the light. Light as opposed to darkness is one of the major themes of the Prologue and of the Gospel as a whole (Gospel: John 1:6-8.19-28). The ministry of John points to that of the Light – mirrored in the oracle of Isaiah that announces the definitive Jubilee (First Reading: Isaiah 61:1-2.10-11). St. Paul reminds the Thessalonians of the joy of the Spirit (Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24).

**Responsorial Psalm meditation:** 'My spirit rejoices in God my Saviour.' (Luke 1:47).

You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.
