Scripture Reflection

Mark's Gospel records a day/night in the ministry of Jesus. It consists of healing – here Peter's mother-in-law and the sick in general, prayer and preaching (Gospel: Mark 1:29-39). Job reflects on the suffering of human life and laments his own situation (First Reading: Job 7:1-4,6-7). Paul talks of his own duty to preach and live the Gospel (Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 9:16-19,22-23).

Responsorial Psalm meditation: 'Praise the Lord for the Lord is good (Psalm 145/146:1).

You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.
