## **Scripture Reflection**

Jesus continues to insist to the crowd and to those who oppose him that he is the living bread from heaven who gives eternal life to those who eat and drink his flesh and blood. The word life and living occur eleven times in these verses (Gospel: John 6:51-58). The luscious banquet given by Lady Wisdom is food for all and here the ignorant become wise (First Reading: Proverbs 9:1-6). St. Paul urges the community to be alive with the Spirit (Second Reading: Ephesians 5:15-20).

Responsorial Psalm meditation: 'I will bless the Lord at all times, his praise always on my lips' (Ps 33/24:1).

You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.

<u>Congratulations</u> to Mrs. Tomkys, all the teachers, governors and students at <u>St. Joseph's School</u>. The recent OFSTED inspection judgment was 'Good' and the Inspector was extremely complimentary about the broad range of the curriculum to help the children flourish.

<u>St. Gregory the Great Secondary School</u>: despite some adverse press, St. Gregory's School is setting things in place for substantial improvement. Mr. Sean Tucker, the acting Head and the SLT have produced a solid School Improvement Plan and the Committee members (governors) have re-organized their structure to correspond with this. St. Gregory's is the only Catholic Secondary school in Oxford and we need to help it to flourish.
