## Scripture Reflection

We begin reading semi-continuously, Sunday by Sunday, the account of the public ministry of Jesus according to the Gospel of Luke. Today, after the repetition of the preface to the Gospel, we have the scene of the Synagogue in Nazareth. This is more detailed here than in the other Gospels, a clear indication that Luke emphasizes the power of the Spirit in Jesus to preach to the poor (Gospel: Luke 1:1-4,4:14-21). After the Exile, the returned community is bound together through the Torah (First Reading: Nehemiah 8:2-6,8-10). St. Paul continues his analogy of the Church being like the human body (Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:12-30).

Responsorial Psalm meditation: “The precepts of the Lord are right, they gladden the heart.” (Ps 18/19:8). You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.
