Scripture Reflection

The Gospel proclaimed today is not an appearance of the Risen Lord but the account of the empty tomb. Mary of Magdala brings Peter and John to the tomb and it is through this empty tomb and the abandoned linen cloths that John is the first to “see and believe” (Gospel: John 20:1-9). At the heart of the narrative of the conversion of Cornelius is the witness of Peter to the death and Resurrection of the Lord (First Reading: Acts 10:34, 37-43). St. Paul teaches the consequences of Baptism – the hidden life of Jesus within us (Second Reading: Colossians 3:1-4).

Responsorial Psalm meditation: “This day was made by the Lord: we rejoice and are glad” (Ps 117/118:24).

You may like to say this as a meditation on your Rosary.

Confirmation June 1st 2019: if your child is in Year 6 then would you please complete the registration form for Confirmation. If anyone else needs to be Confirmed then would he/she also fill in a form. Confirmation is not an optional Sacrament - it is required to be a full member of the Church. Forms for registration for **First Holy Communion (Year 3 children or above) are also available. First Holy Communion will be on Sunday June 16th 2019.**

Pilgrimage to the Holy Land: September 3rd – 11th 2019. It will officially be a Diocesan pilgrimage and Bishop David McGough will be coming. But we could have a substantial number from Corpus Christi and Oxford if we start to book early enough. The itinerary and price are the same as last year: all inclusive for £1496.00 (+ £355 for single room). This is a very good price for 5 nights in Bethlehem and 3 nights in Tiberius.
