## The Preaching of St. John

Pieter Bruegel the Elder ca. 1520 - 1569 Museum of Fine Arts. Budapest

Today's Gospel: John declared before them all: "I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out.'

ruegel would often use biblical themes to depict village-life as he knew it. This is another fine example. The viewer's attention is first drawn to the figures in the foreground, then to the river in the background and only then to John the Baptist, wearing a garment of camel hair.


## Liturgical colour: rose (or violet)

ose is a lighter version of violet, because today the penitential violet is mixed with the white of the approaching festival.

It is part of human nature that we cannot go on being penitent for a long time, or we sink into a settled and insincere gloom rather than working at the definite and active spiritual exercise called penance. The Church knows human nature, and both in Advent and Lent there is a moment where the atmosphere of penance and preparation is brightened by a shaft of light from the glorious season we are preparing ourselves for.

rejoice! The third Sunday of Advent tells us 'Gaudéte, rejoice!' audete because the Lord is near and the fourth Sunday of Lent says 'Lætáre, Ierúsalem, be joyful, Jerusalem, and all who love her!' because she herself is loved by the Lord. On Gaudete and Laetare Sundays, therefore, the dark penitential violet may be lightened to what the documents call 'rose' but most laymen would call 'pink'.

## Scripture Reflection

Luke presents the different groups who come to John the Baptist for his baptism: the people as a whole, some tax collectors and some soldiers. He orders them to follow what are usual prophetic principles of social justice. John also points to the much more powerful and definitive baptism of the One to come (Gospel: Luke 3:10-18). Zephaniah urges Jerusalem to rejoice with the description of the Lord among them as the one who fights and dances with his people (First Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-18). The joy flowing from the Lord saving his people (being literally their Yeshua (Jesus) - salvation) is sung of also by Isaiah (Responsorial Psalm: Isaiah 12). Paul urges the Christians in Philippi to demonstrate their deep joy (Greek: chaire - still used as a greeting in modern Greek) that the Lord is coming soon (Second Reading: Philippians 4:4-7).


